All vessels 100 gross register tonnage or greater must contact Whangarei Harbour Radio on VHF Channel 11 thirty minutes prior to passing the Fairway Buoy inwards; prior to leaving the berth; and at Snake Bank Beacon reporting point.

NZ 5215

RADIO REPORTING POINTS

All vessels 100 gross register tonnage or greater must contact Whangarei Harbour Radio on VHF Channel 11 prior to leaving the berth; at Snake Bank Beacon; and Wellington Rock Beacon reporting points.

NZ 5219

RADIO REPORTING POINTS

All vessels 100 gross register tonnage or greater must contact Whangarei Harbour Radio on VHF Channel 11 thirty minutes prior to passing the Fairway Buoy inwards and prior to leaving the berth.
